

Homeschool Parent Agreement



There are three important areas in our relationship with Crossroads Church that arise from three specific needs:

1. Ensuring the safety of the children in STARS preschool.
2. Ensuring that the facility is left “church –ready” when we leave after classes
3. Honoring our host

The preschool security requires the following policies:

1. Please enter and exit the building only through the front doors.
2. Please do not walk through the corridors on Hall 100
3. The indoor play area is available for children, Kindergarten age and under. Children must be supervised. On days with inclement weather Crossroads STARS preschool will have priority in use of this area. At these times homeschool children cannot be in the play area. On such occasions only, room 122 will be available as an additional waiting room for families with young children to use.
4. Children must be supervised at all times when not in the classroom
5. Loitering is prohibited.
6. Use of alcohol, drugs, firearms or knives is prohibited.

Church readiness requires the following policies:

1. Room 124 will be available as a general waiting room for parents and children at all times. Please only use this room or play area as specified in other points.
2. Homeschool families are requested to please only use the bathrooms in the “Nex Gen” area.
3. Please leave these areas clean and in suitable condition for Wednesday night church use.

Honoring our host requires the following policies:

1. Parking along the curb or in any “No Parking” or “Fire Zone” is prohibited. Vehicles will be towed at owner’s expense without warning.
2. Crossroads Church will not be responsible for the security of any person, vehicle or property of those using the parking area.
3. Littering the parking lots or grounds is prohibited.
4. Use of profane, vulgar or indecent language, music or symbols is prohibited.
